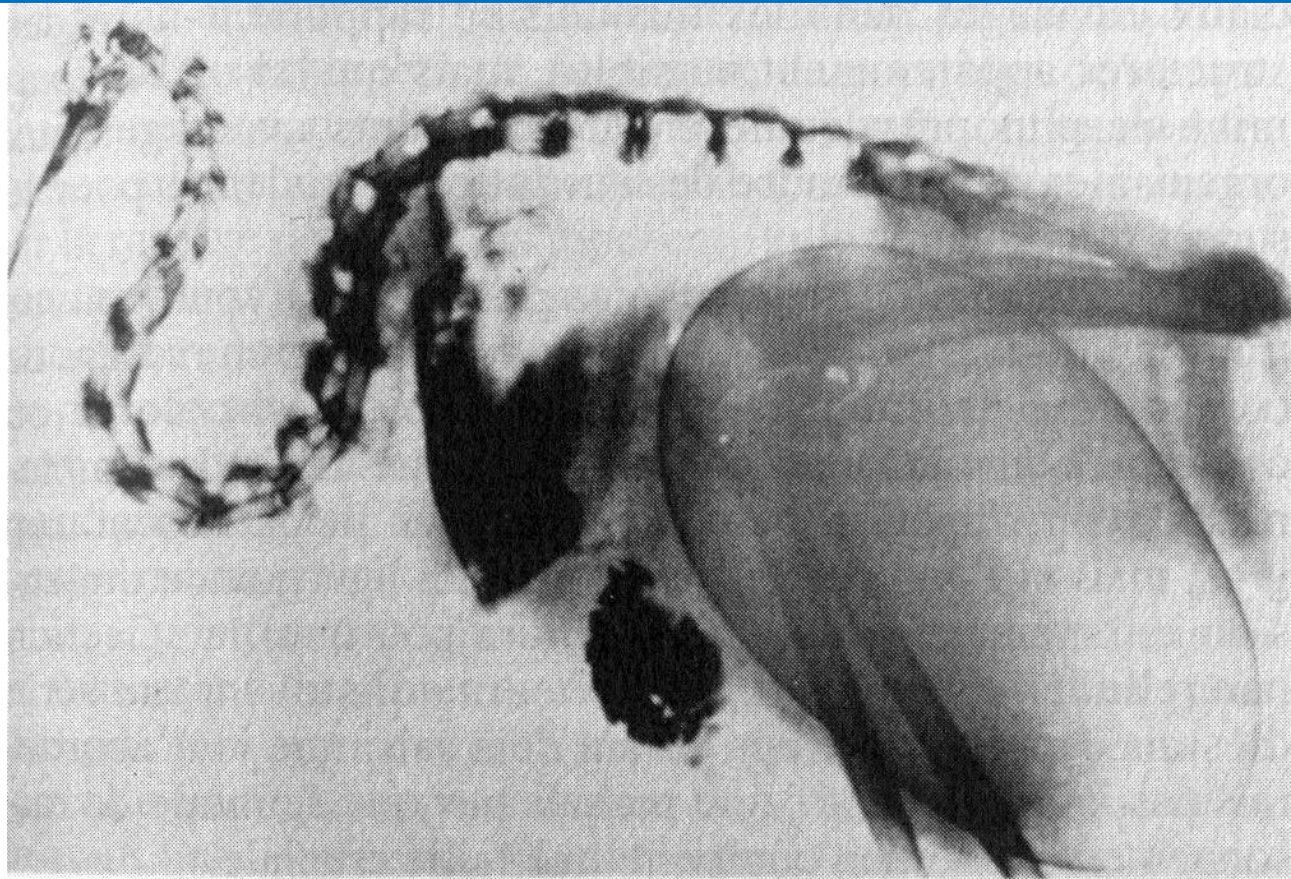

Evolution of the recurrent laryngeal nerve. (a) In fish, the vagus nerve sends direct branches between successive gill arches. (b) In mammals, the gill arches have evolved into a very different circulatory system. The descendant nerve of the fish's fourth vagus now passes from the brain, down to the heart (in the thorax) and back up to the larynx.
